Motion was made to purchase \$200 worth of plants for the planters around Lincoln Park, contingent upon the Mayor's approval; Mike/Chet – passed.

Scholarship Committee – Barb had contacted Millville High School and initially the idea was to give the scholarship to a student from Woodbine who attended Millville HS. But since there are Woodbine students who would then not be eligible for the scholarship since they attend other schools such as the Technical HS, Wildwood Catholic or Cape Christian, etc. The chamber decided to offer the scholarship to any student from Woodbine. Motion was made to offer one \$500 scholarship this year; Mike/Chet – passed.

SPECIAL ORDER:

NEW BUSINESS:

Motion was made to approve \$2000 budget for advertising for the Festival to be used to purchase large banners to advertise the Festival and as the committee sees fit; Mike/Nancy – passed.
